Review or simplify institutional policies and rules that do not support people-centered care

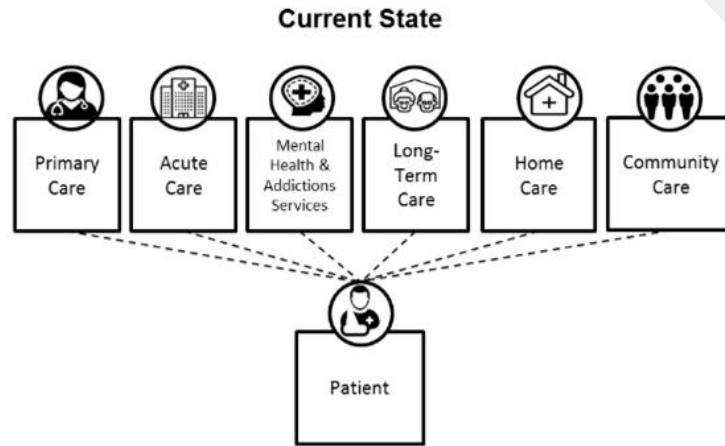


Look at novel ways of working together (Governance)

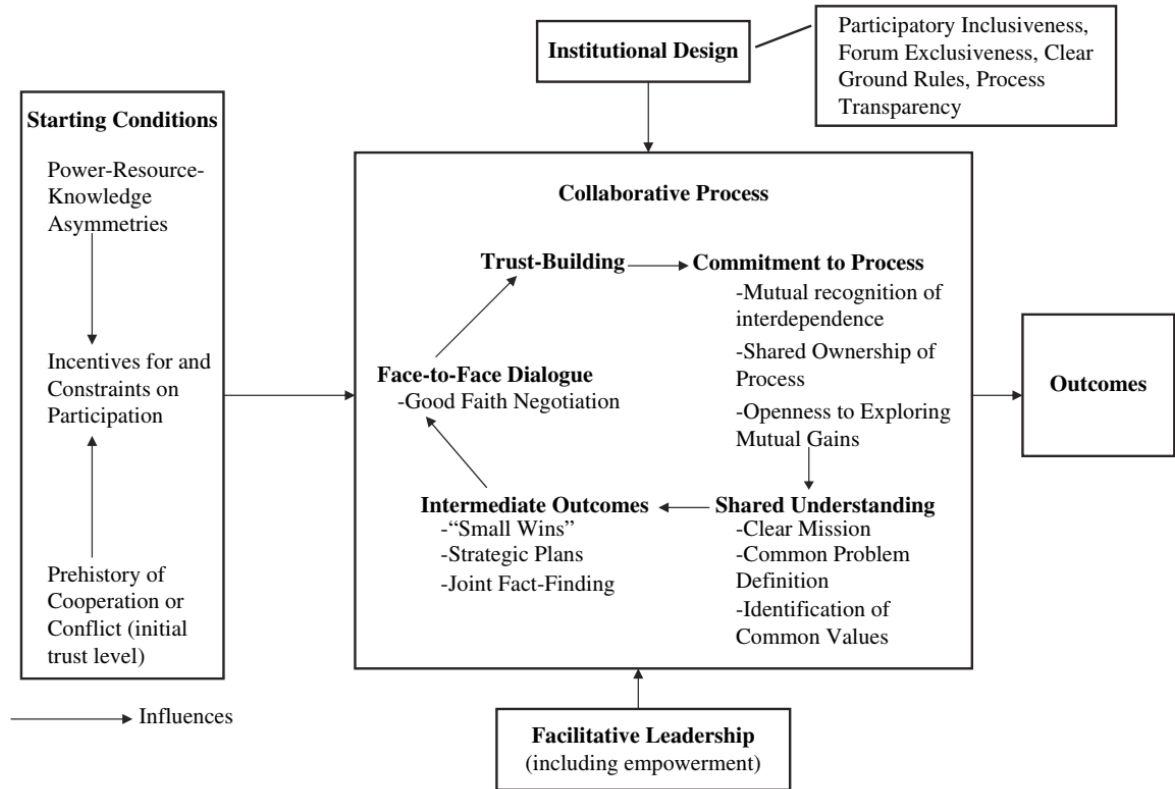
Near future healthcare landscape

A Model of Collaborative Governance

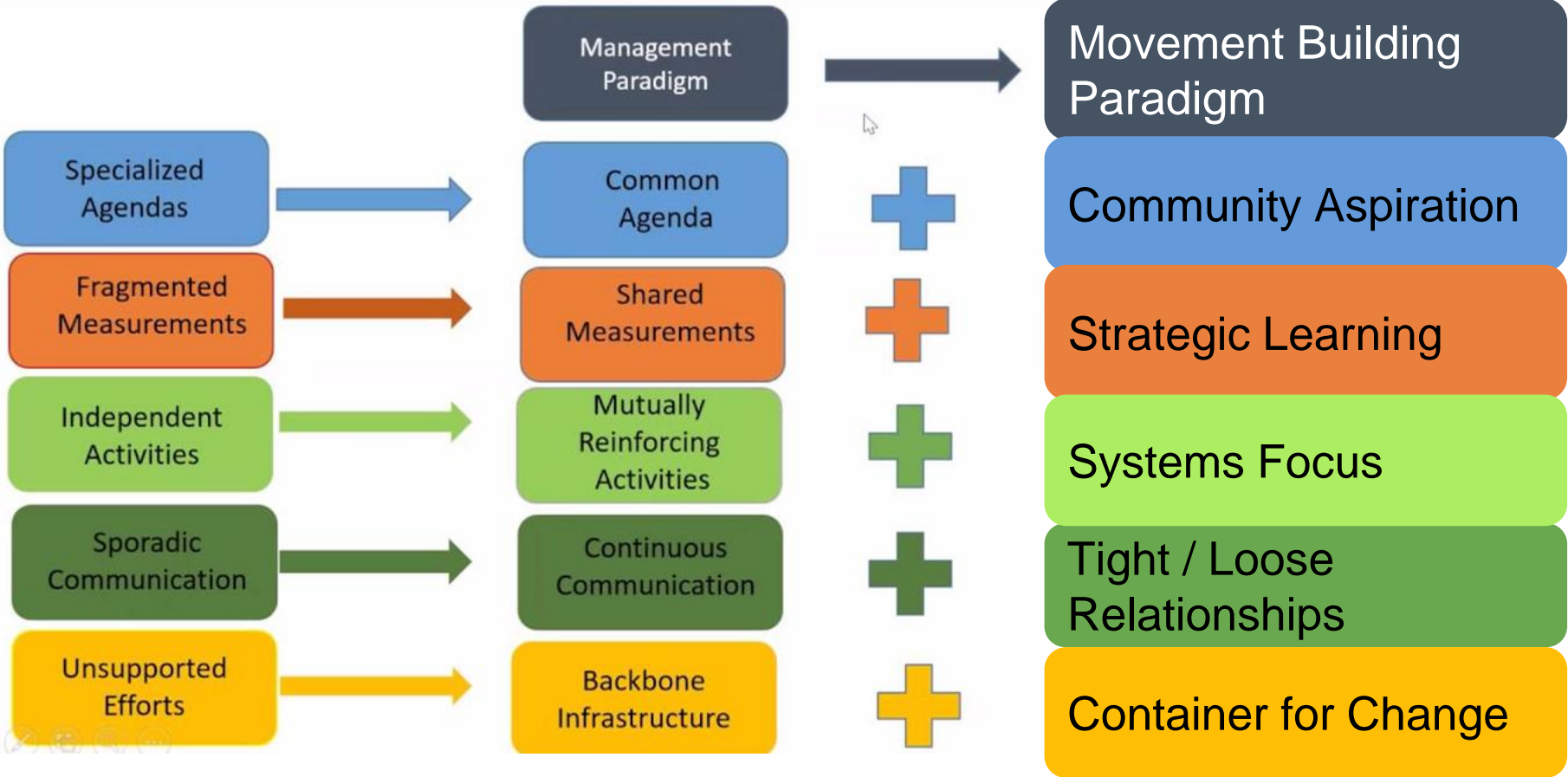

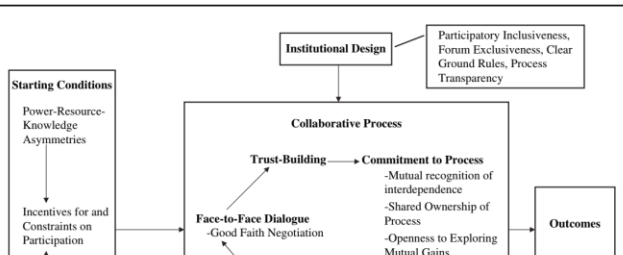
